1. When Facing Temptation

A. Recognize the <u>source</u> of temptation.

James 1:12-14

¹² God blesses those who patiently endure testing and temptation. Afterward they will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him. ¹³ And remember, when you are being tempted, do not say, "God is tempting me." God is never tempted to do wrong, and he never tempts anyone else. ¹⁴ Temptation comes from our own desires, which entice us and drag us away.

B. Recognize the <u>seriousness</u> of temptation.

James 1:15

These desires give birth to sinful actions. And when sin is allowed to grow, it gives birth to death. So don't be misled, my dear brothers and sisters.

John 10:10

The thief's purpose is to steal and kill and destroy. My purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life.

2. When Fighting Temptation, Remember ...

A. You are not just choosing; you preferring something better.

James 1:16-17

¹⁶ So don't be misled, my dear brothers and sisters. ¹⁷ Whatever is good and perfect comes down to us from God our Father, who created all the lights in the heavens. He never changes or casts a shifting shadow.

B. You are not "just saying no," you are saying "yes" to the <u>fresh activity</u> of God within you.

James 1:18

He chose to give birth to us by giving us his true word. And we, out of all creation, became his prized possession.

C. <u>Personal</u> battles don't have to be <u>private</u> battles.

James 1:16

So don't be misled, my dear brothers and sisters.
