You won't! You'll have ...a God, essentially, of your own making, and not a God with whom you can have a relationship and genuine interaction.



Only if your God can say things that outrage you and make you struggle (as in real friendship or marriage!)



will you know that you have gotten hold of a real God and not a figment of your imagination.



So an authoritative Bible is not the enemy of a personal relationship with God. It is the precondition for it.



Engage wise believers present and past.



Ask for God's wisdom.
