## 1. Two Fundamental Forgiveness Problems

A. We confuse our <u>inability</u> to forgive with God's <u>ability</u> to forgive.

B. We may not feel forgiven because we don't feel good enough to be forgiven.

- Unfinished <u>business</u>
- Inability to bring <u>closure</u>
- Consequential <u>reminders</u>
- "If you only knew" <u>stories</u>

#### **Matthew 12:31**

And so I tell you, every kind of sin and slander can be forgiven, but blasphemy against the Spirit will not be forgiven.
